"I hope Energy Shift to be the leading platform for investment in clean and renewable energy, creating impact and helping European citizens, as joining an EU Climate Pact network of ambassadors provided me training and opportunity to present Energy Shift to the wide public as well as talk about the Energy policy in Europe." he said.

But only with the EYE programme he could transform his business idea into reality and create a blockchain powered platform that enables citizens to jointly invest in and co-own solar farms. Working in a solar installation company, learning about the solar systems design and how it is set up was vital in getting me to where I am now," highlighted Koprčina.

He also has established connections with the other entrepreneurs, EU institutions officers and local policy makers.
