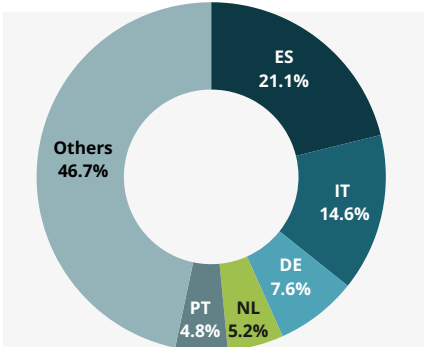
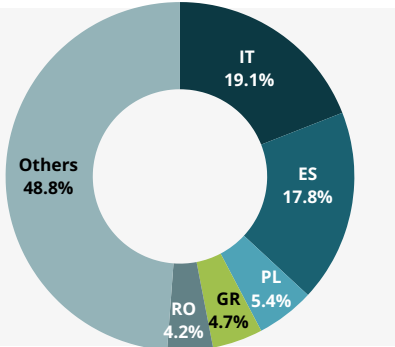

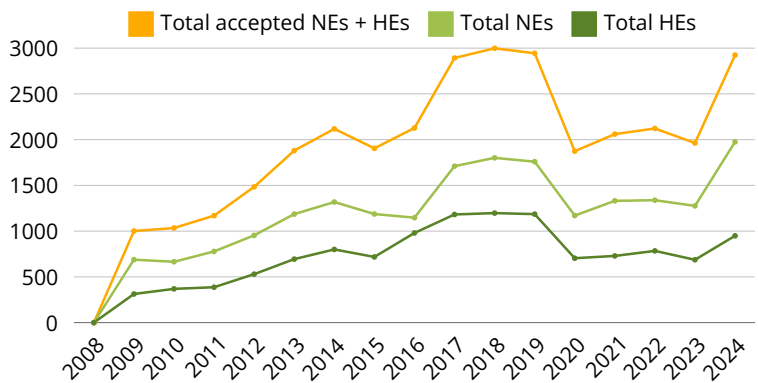
TOP 5 COUNTRIES OF ORIGIN ACCEPTED NEW ENTREPRENEURS



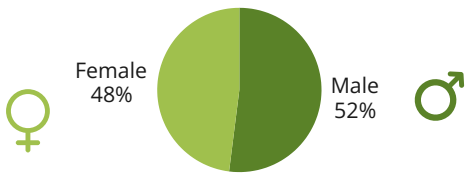
TOP 5 COUNTRIES OF ORIGIN ACCEPTED HOST ENTREPRENEURS

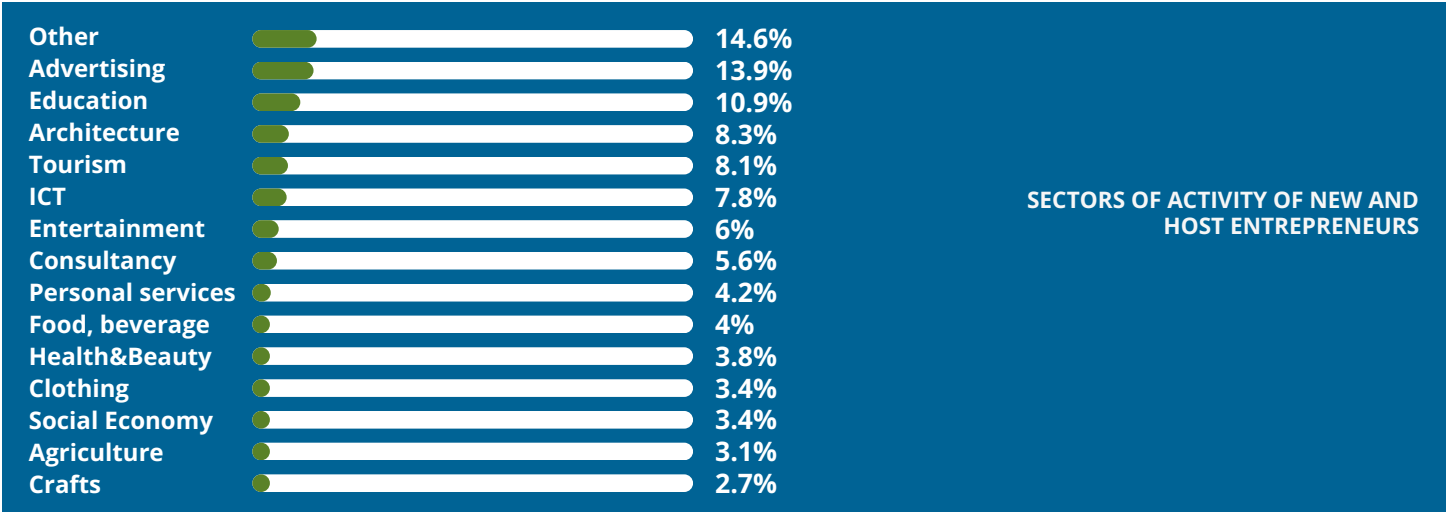
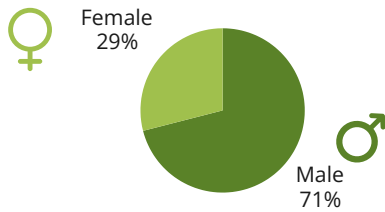
32,469 is the number of entrepreneurs who have successfully been accepted for the programme since it started in 2009. This number represents 58% of the total amount of applications received. New entrepreneurs account for 66%, and Host entrepreneurs for 34%.



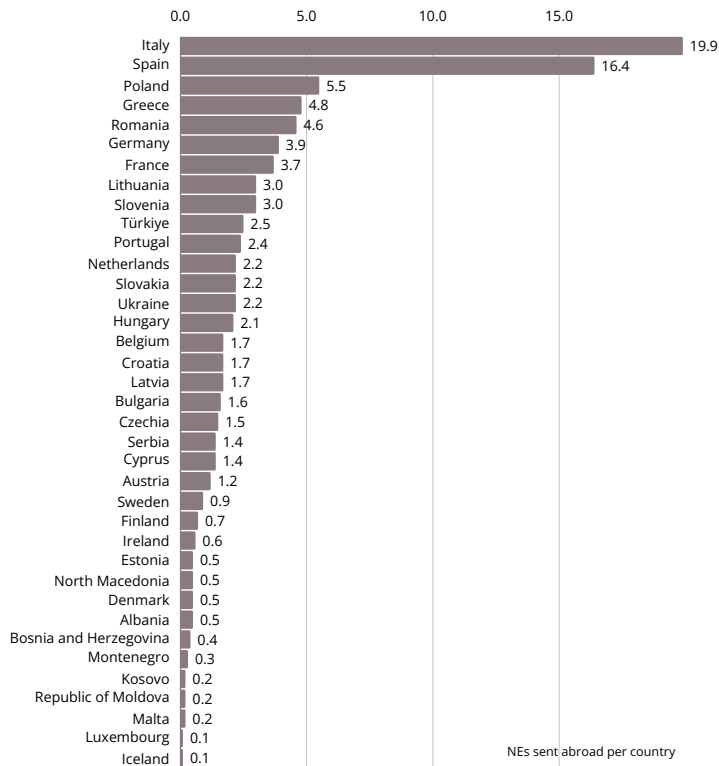
Registered New Entrepreneurs (NEs)



Registered Host Entrepreneurs (HEs)

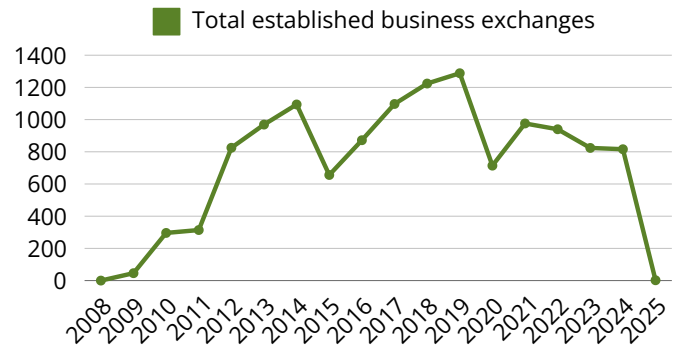

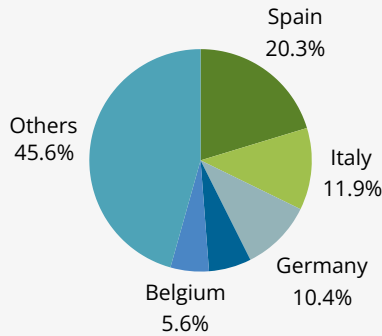

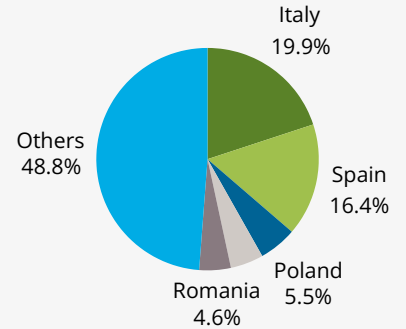
Since its launch in 2009, 12,839 exchanges have been established across the EU Member States and additional participating countries of which 11,962 are completed.



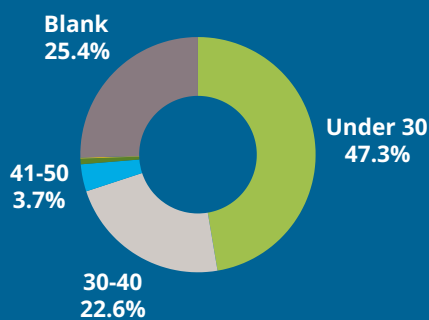
Spain leads as the most sought-after destination, hosting 2,585 exchanges, followed by Italy with 1,519 exchanges. Germany comes in third with 1,321 exchanges, followed by the Netherlands (787), and Belgium (711).



The top countries where new entrepreneurs predominantly come from are Italy with 2,561, Spain with 2,102, Poland with 706, Greece with 617, and Romania with 589.
