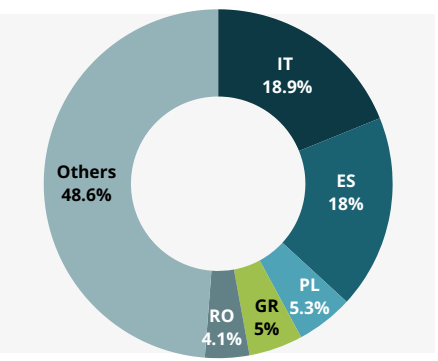

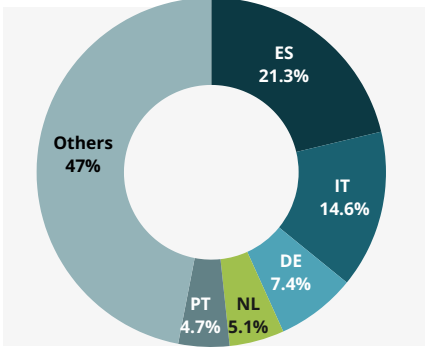

TOP 5 COUNTRIES OF ORIGIN ACCEPTED NEW ENTREPRENEURS

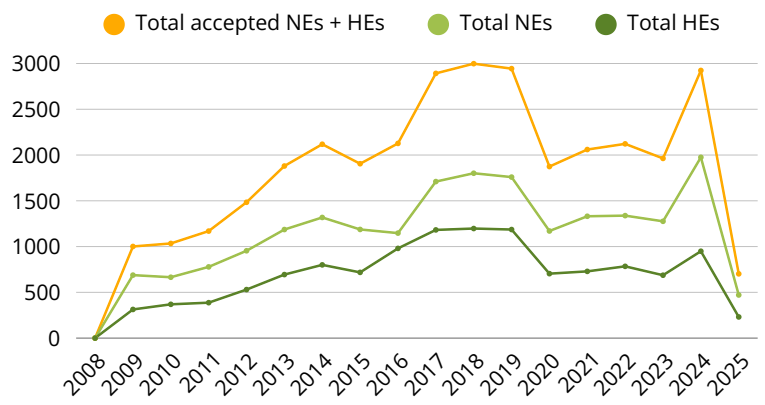

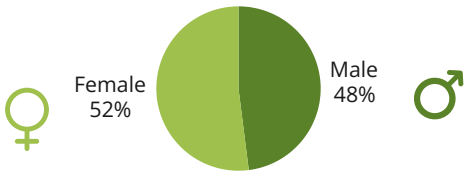
33,551 is the number of entrepreneurs who have successfully been accepted for the programme since it started in 2009. This number represents 58% of the total amount of applications received. New entrepreneurs account for 66%, and Host entrepreneurs for 34%.



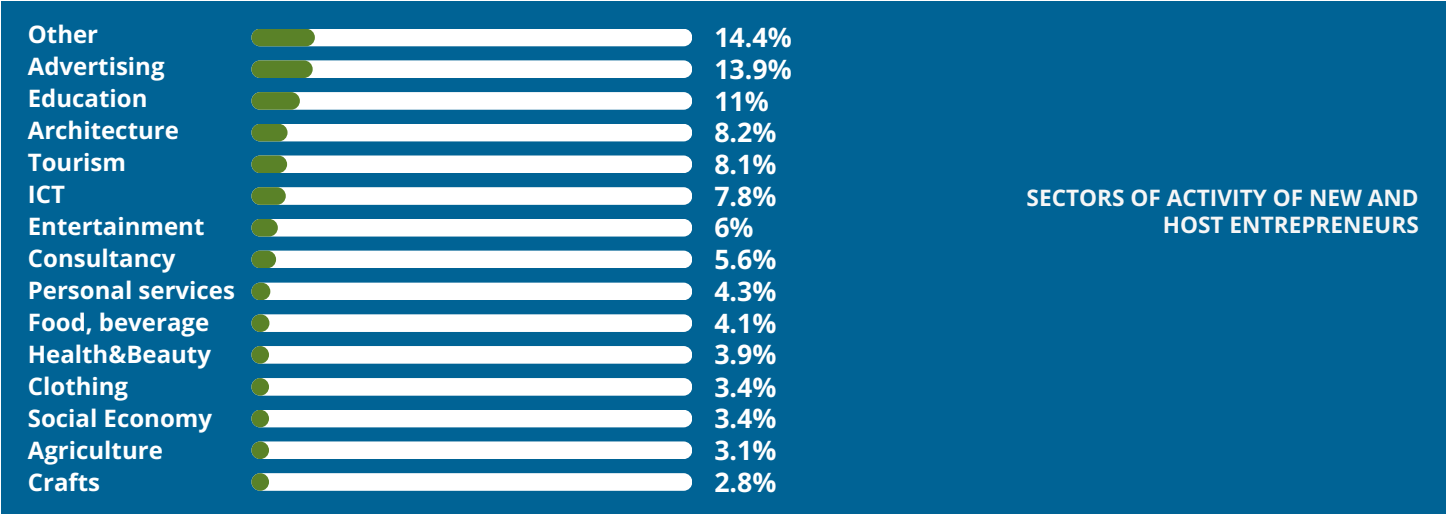
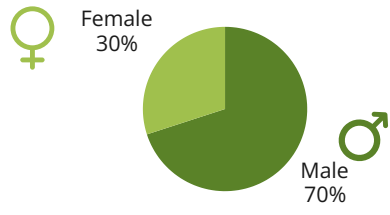
TOP 5 COUNTRIES OF ORIGIN ACCEPTED HOST ENTREPRENEURS



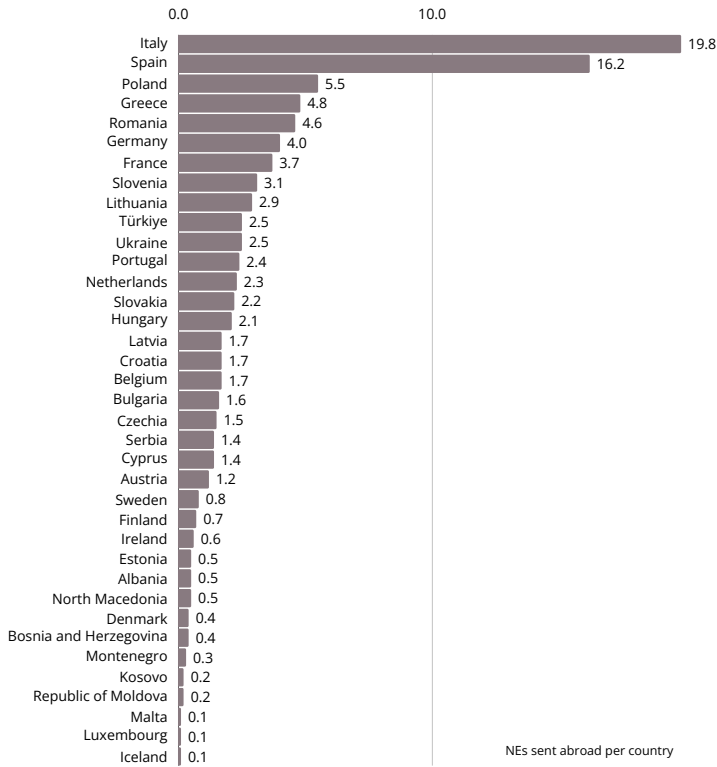
Registered New Entrepreneurs (NEs)



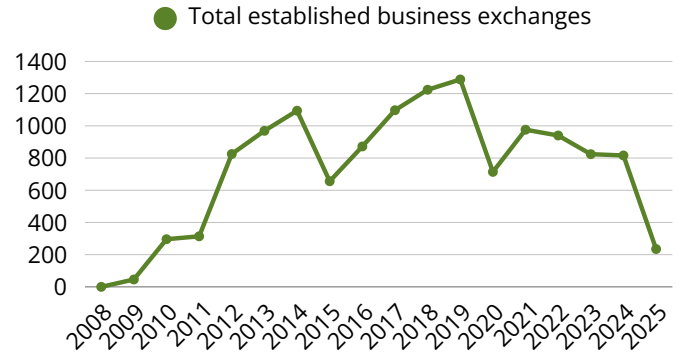
Registered Host Entrepreneurs (HEs)



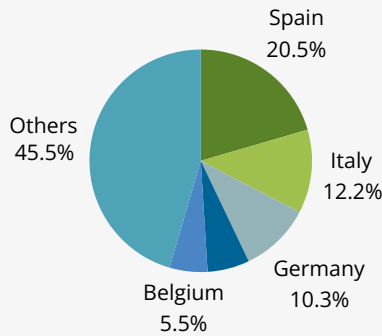
SECTORS OF ACTIVITY OF NEW AND HOST ENTREPRENEURS



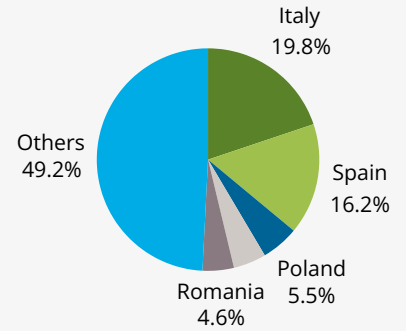
Since its launch in 2009, 13,142 exchanges have been established across the EU Member States and additional participating countries of which 12,155 are completed.



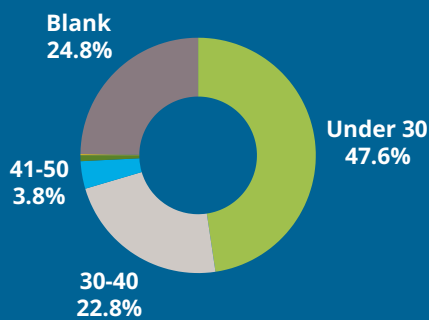
Spain leads as the most sought-after destination, hosting 2,693 exchanges, followed by Italy with 1,597 exchanges. Germany comes in third with 1,349 exchanges, followed by the Netherlands (803), and Belgium (725).



The top countries where new entrepreneurs predominantly come from are Italy with 2,608, Spain with 2,126, Poland with 718, Greece with 627, and Romania with 598.
