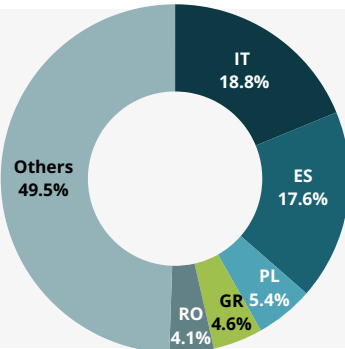

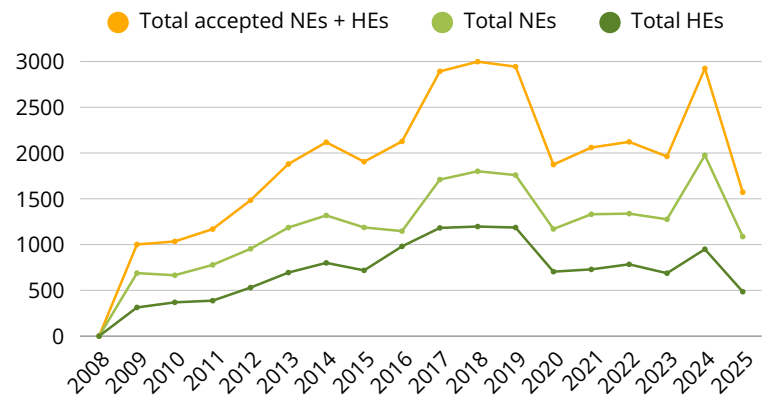

TOP 5 COUNTRIES OF ORIGIN ACCEPTED NEW ENTREPRENEURS

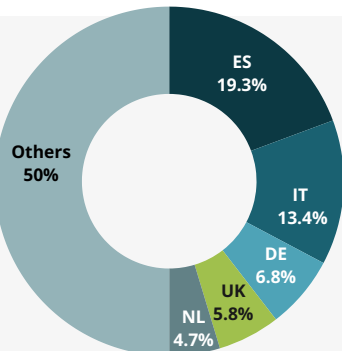

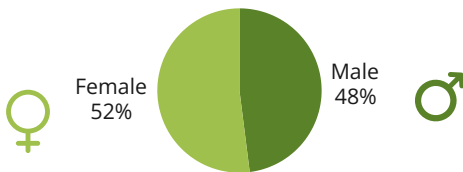

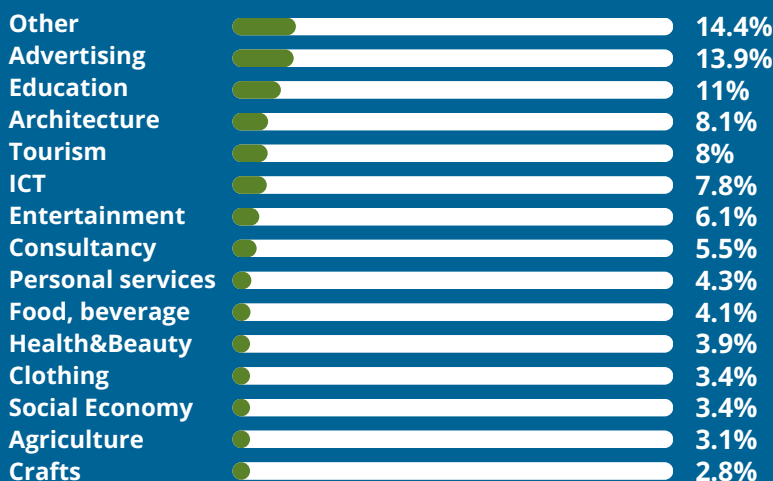
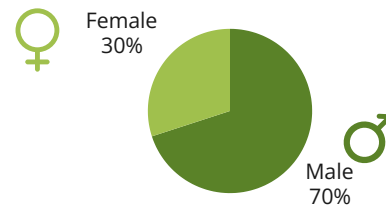
TOP 5 COUNTRIES OF ORIGIN ACCEPTED HOST ENTREPRENEURS



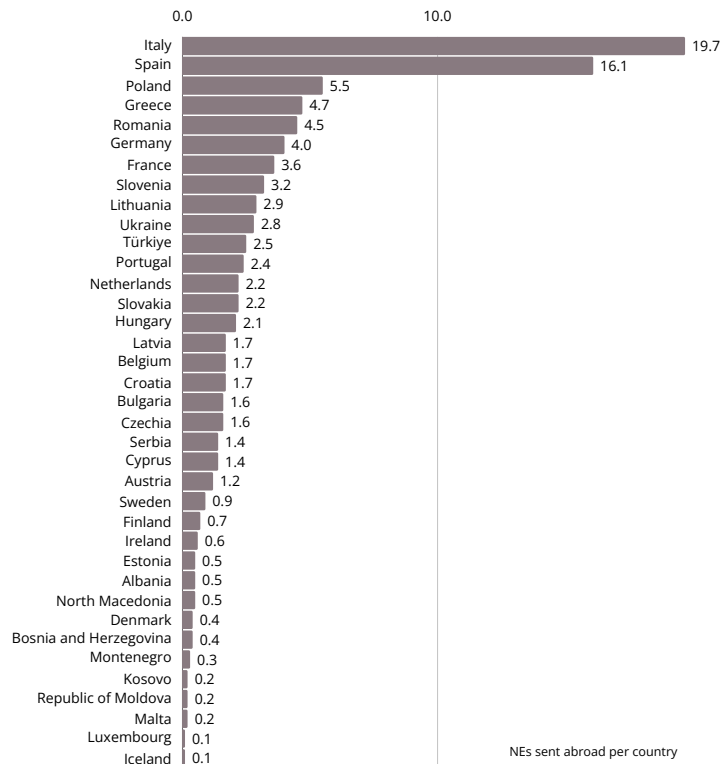
Registered New Entrepreneurs (NEs)



Registered Host Entrepreneurs (HEs)

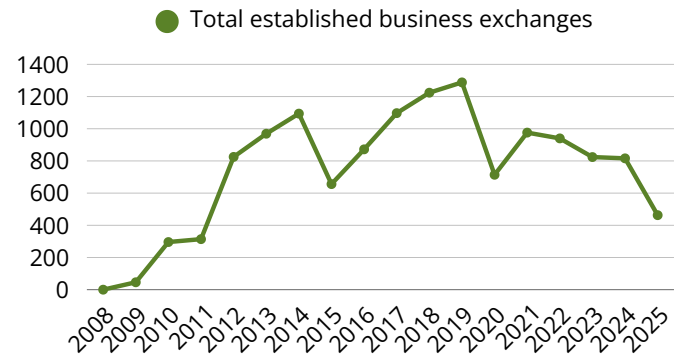


SECTORS OF ACTIVITY OF NEW AND HOST ENTREPRENEURS

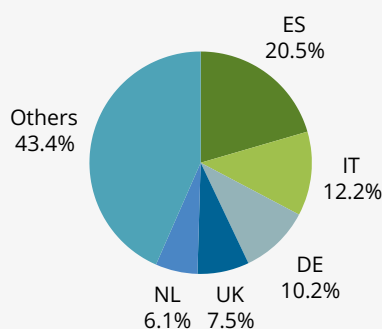

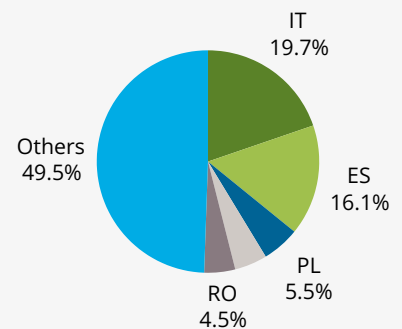
Since its launch in 2009, 13,367 exchanges have been established across the EU Member States and additional participating countries of which 12,295 are completed.



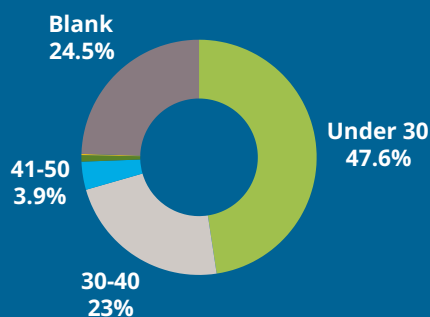
Spain leads as the most sought-after destination, hosting 2,739 exchanges, followed by Italy with 1,635 exchanges. Germany comes in third with 1,365 exchanges, followed by the UK (1006), and the Netherlands (818).



The top countries where new entrepreneurs predominantly come from are Italy with 2,639, Spain with 2,153, Poland with 730, Greece with 634, and Romania with 601.
