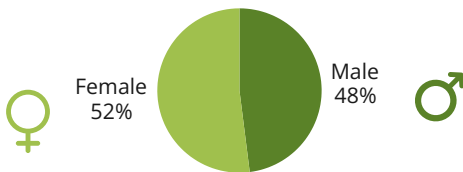
34.9K

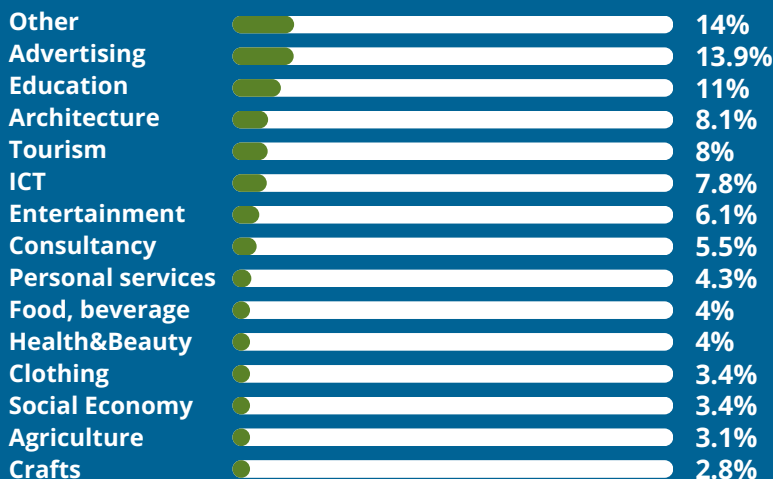
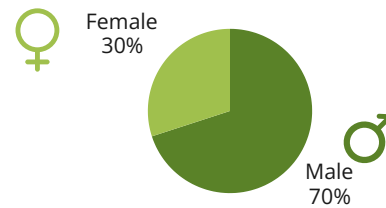

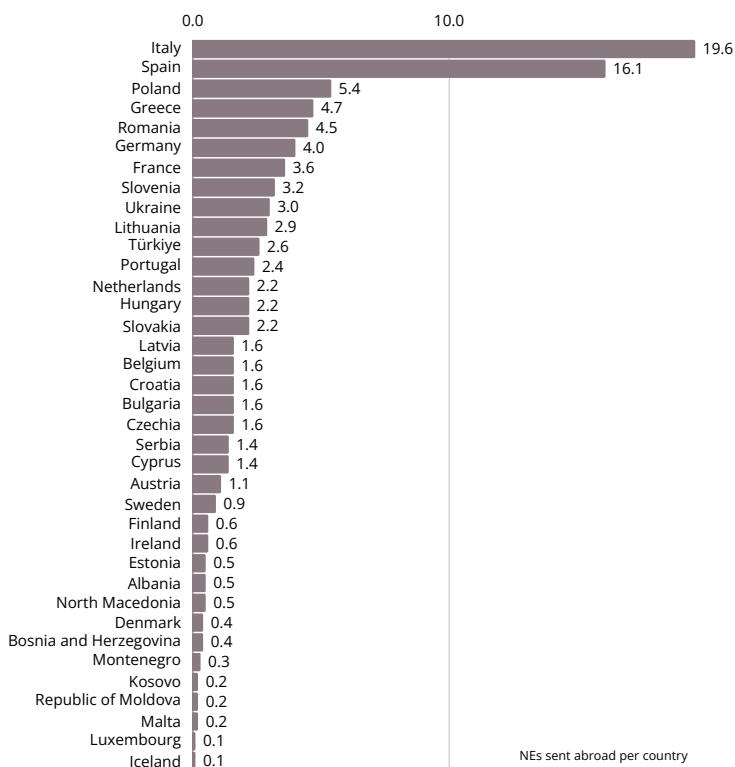
Registered New Entrepreneurs (NEs)



Registered Host Entrepreneurs (HEs)

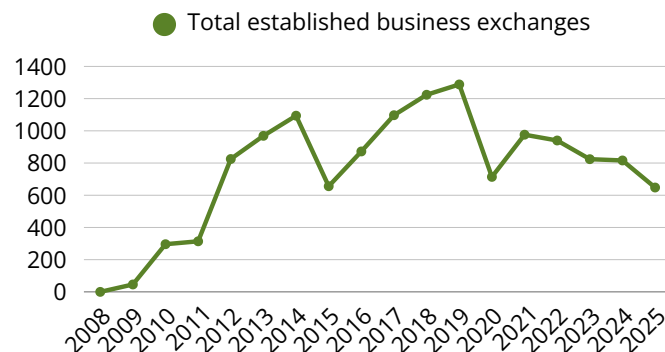


SECTORS OF ACTIVITY OF NEW AND
HOST ENTREPRENEURS

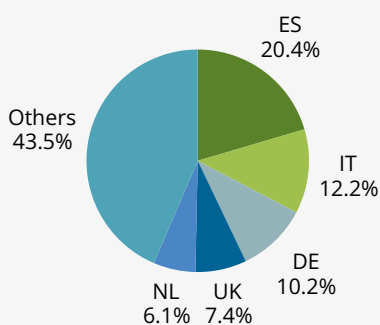

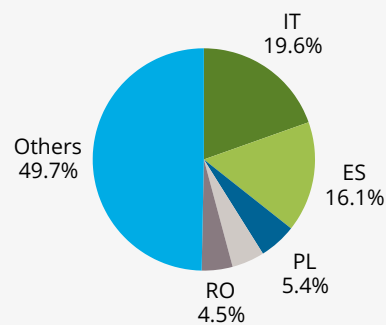
Since its launch in 2009, 13,548 exchanges have been established across the EU Member States and additional participating countries of which 12,453 are completed.



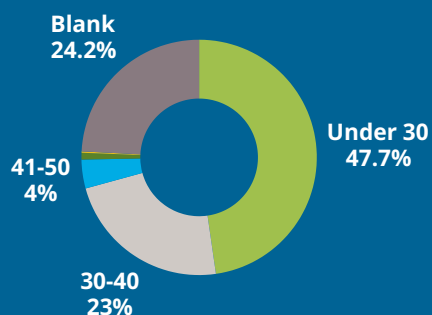
Spain leads as the most sought-after destination, hosting 2,768 exchanges, followed by Italy with 1,659 exchanges. Germany comes in third with 1,384 exchanges, followed by the UK (1008), and the Netherlands (829).



The top countries where new entrepreneurs predominantly come from are Italy with 2,651, Spain with 2,179, Poland with 736, Greece with 643, and Romania with 608.
