
36,860 is the number of entrepreneurs who have successfully been accepted for the programme since it started in 2009. New entrepreneurs account for 65%, and Host entrepreneurs for 35%. Out of the 7311 applications received in 2025, 3577 have been accepted in the programme.





## Registered New Entrepreneurs (NEs)



## Registered Host Entrepreneurs (HEs)








Since its launch in 2009, 14,205 exchanges have been established across the EU Member States and additional participating countries of which 13,038 are completed.



Spain leads as the most sought-after destination, hosting 2,916 exchanges, followed by Italy with 1,766 exchanges. Germany comes in third with 1,429 exchanges, followed by the UK (1021), and the Netherlands (848).



The top countries where new entrepreneurs predominantly come from are Italy with 2,727, Spain with 2,226, Poland with 773, Greece with 676, and Romania with 624.
