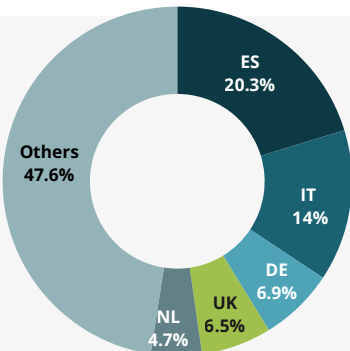

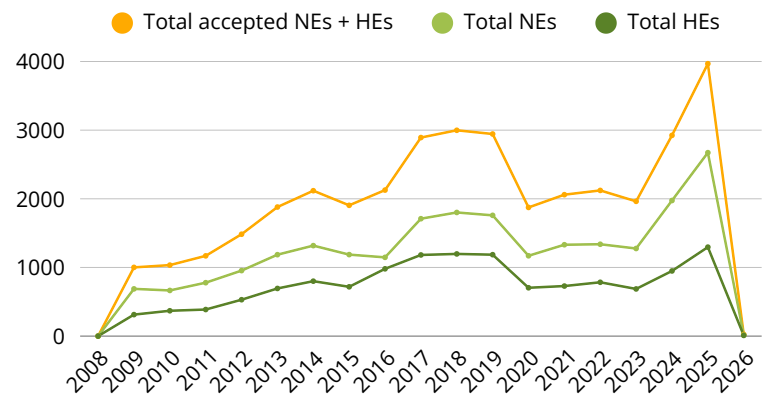

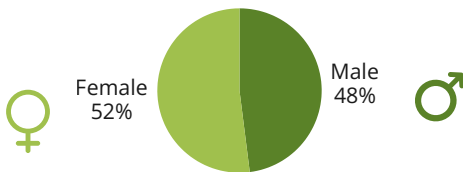

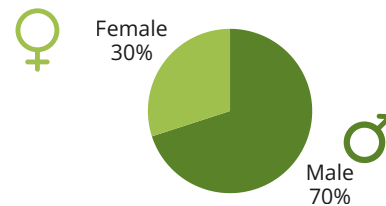
37,236 is the number of entrepreneurs who have successfully been accepted for the programme since it started in 2009. New entrepreneurs account for 65%, and Host entrepreneurs for 35%. Out of the 7923 applications received in 2025, 3968 have been accepted in the programme.



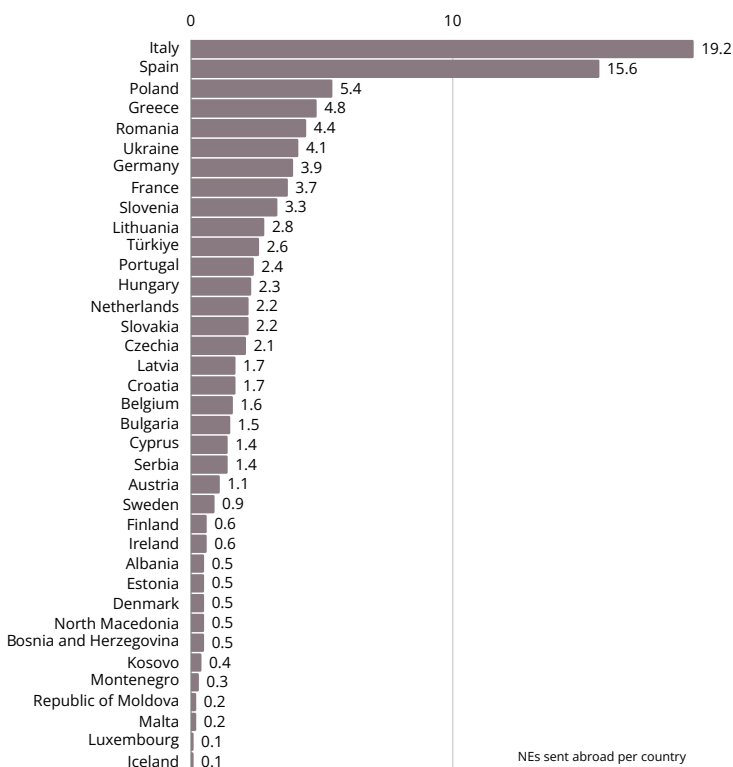
Registered New Entrepreneurs (NEs)



Registered Host Entrepreneurs (HEs)

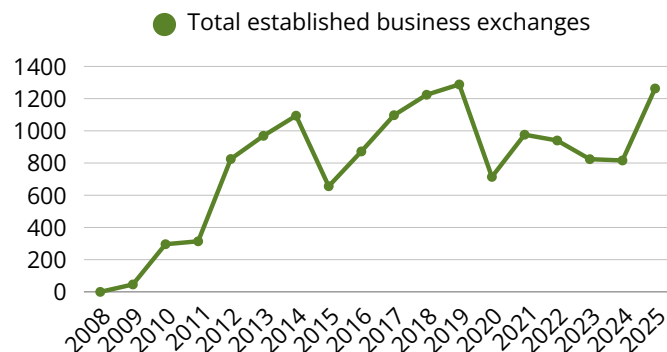

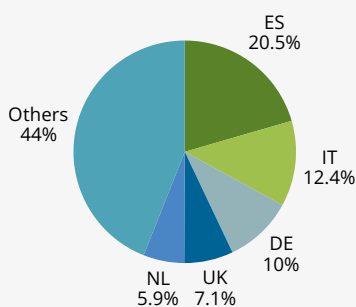

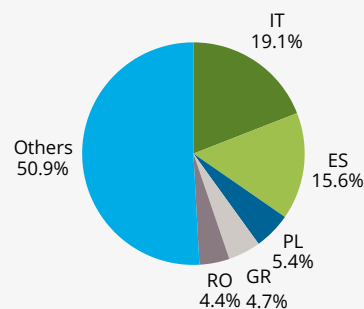
Since its launch in 2009, 14,363 exchanges have been established across the EU Member States and additional participating countries of which 13,222 are completed.



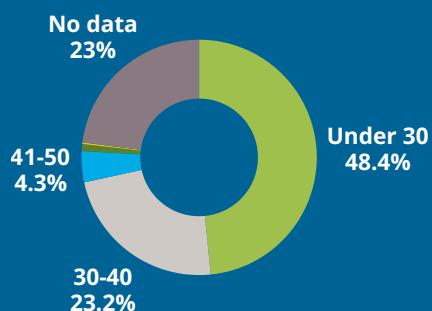
Spain leads as the most sought-after destination, hosting 2,964 exchanges, followed by Italy with 1,785 exchanges. Germany comes in third with 1,438 exchanges, followed by the UK (1023), and the Netherlands (854).



The top countries where new entrepreneurs predominantly come from are Italy with 2,753, Spain with 2,241, Poland with 780, Greece with 691, and Romania with 625.
